GQ TESTS GOING TO GREAT LENGTHS

Can SizeGenetics' new kit really add mass to your manhood? GQ's **James Mullinger** tries it out for size

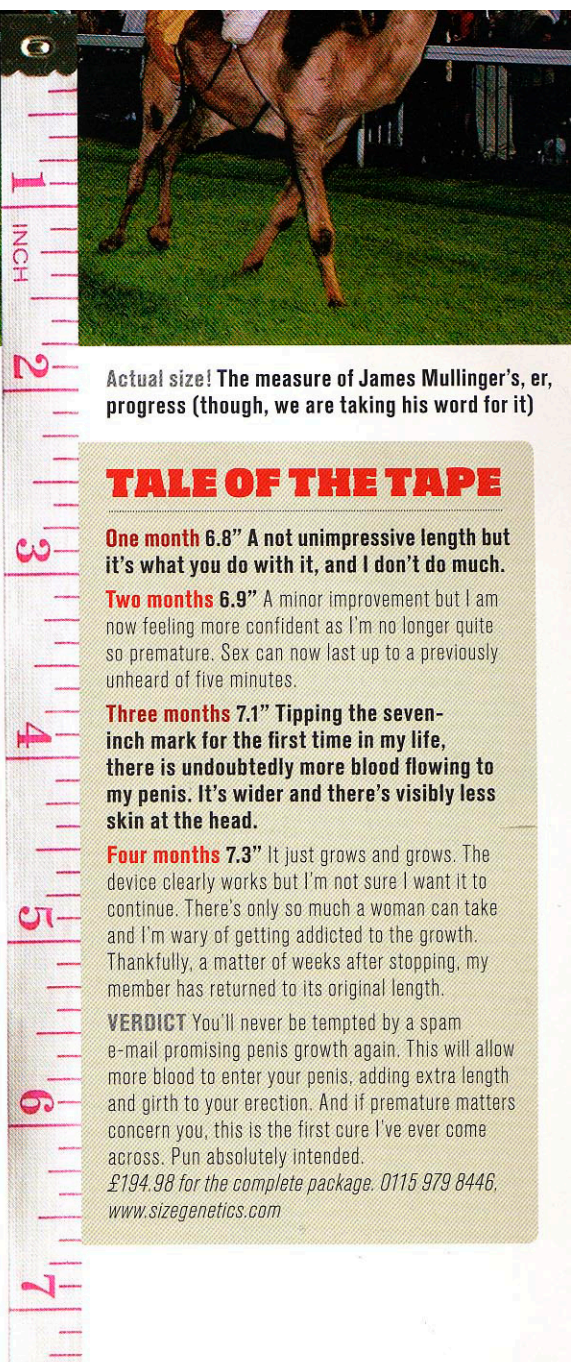


Like most GQ men, I have never had any complaints about the length of my penis. I can confess, however, that I have long suffered with a severe case of relationship-crippling premature ejaculation. So when a revolutionary new penis enlargement kit arrived in the office, which also promised to delay climax, I was the first in line (in a queue of one) to test it.

The SizeGenetics penis extender (*right*), it is claimed, increases a member's length and girth by 30 per cent over six months. It works by applying a constant traction over the length of the penis, and you can wear the kit for up to ten hours a day. By being exposed to a durable and regular pull, the penis adapts and adjusts to this force, growing new bulky tissue cells.
